1. Introduction

Oleja Construction Ltd is committed to conducting business responsibly and ethically. We take a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery, human trafficking, forced labour, and exploitation of any kind within our operations and supply chains.

2. Our Business and Supply Chains

Right to Work and ID Verification Procedure

Whistleblowing Policy

All staff, contractors, and suppliers are expected to comply with these policies and uphold ethical standards.

4. Due Diligence and Risk Management

We conduct due diligence when engaging new suppliers and subcontractors, including:

Verifying legal working status of all labour

Reviewing subcontractor compliance with UK employment law

Assessing risk based on sector, geography, and service type

Monitoring for signs of exploitation on-site

5. Training and Awareness

Oleja Construction Ltd is committed to raising awareness of modern slavery risks. We provide:

Induction training on modern slavery for all new staff

Annual refreshers and toolbox talks for site operatives

Guidance for managers on identifying and reporting concerns

6. Monitoring and Reporting

We encourage employees and partners to report any suspicions of modern slavery. Reports are investigated in line with our grievance and whistleblowing procedures. No incidents have been reported to date.

Expand supplier audits for higher-risk categories

Update due diligence processes for subcontractor onboarding

Review all policies annually for effectiveness

Increase engagement with ethical sourcing initiatives
